MARICOPA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 6 REGULATION OF BARKING DOGS

It shall be unlawful for any person having custody or control of a dog in any unincorporated area of Maricopa County to permit that dog to bark excessively. For purpose of this Ordinance, a bark, yowl, yip or any other noise made naturally by a dog shall be deemed to be a bark.

Upon receiving a complaint about a barking dog, the County Enforcement Agent shall investigate the circumstances and recommend a mediator to resolve any dispute between any person violating this ordinance and any aggrieved person.

The recommendation of the County Enforcement Agent shall be in addition to, and shall not preclude, any other remedy provided by law.
