

Minutes of the Public Board Meeting of February 28, 2022

The meeting was called to order by President Hoagland at 9:00 a.m.

Meeting Agenda was approved with no changes.

President's Opening Remarks:

Treasurer reported that we are on Budget. 3 fraudulent checks were recovered and funds have been returned to our account.

- Schoa is working on county legislation to remove age overlay permits from the purview of the County Board of Adjustment.
